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1. Marking the Door

- **1.1.** Mark the edge of your door at the desired height of your handle.
- 1.2. We recommend around 900mm 1100mm from floor level, or at the centre of a lock rail on a panel door. (Figure 1)
- 1.3. Using a spirit level, mark the door at the desired lever height, continuing the line from the front of the door, around the edge and onto the back of the door. (Figure 2)
- **1.4.** We recommend extending the line 100mm onto each face of the door.





2. Install Latch, Privacy Bolt & Striker Plate

As per supplier instructions.

3. Prepare Tie Bolts

if using face fix timber screws, proceed to step 4

3.1. If required, shorten tie bolts to suit door thickness. (Figure 3.)



3.2. Ensure to cut so that the screw does not protrude from the opposite rose once installed. (Figure 4.)



4. Install Privacy Adaptor Snib Release

4.1. Slide spring over snib neck and place neck through hole in internal backplate. (Figure 5.)





4.2. Affix circlip to groove in snib neck on inside of backplate. (Figure 6.)4.3. Repeat for security release on externalfacing backplate.

PLEASE NOTE:

The screws provided with Bankston products are made from solid brass. This allows finishes to be matched as closely as possible and prevents the possibility of screws rusting in coastal areas. Please note that screws require pre-drilling.

Please take extra care when fitting.

5. Install Levers

- **5.1.** Place the split spindles into the lock body from either side of the door*.
- **5.2.** Place privacy spindle through privacy bolt follower.
- 5.3. Align the halves with the lever and privacy spindles on either side of the door. Push until flush with the door, ensuring the levers function in the correct direction.
- **5.4.** Insert male tie bolts through top and bottom of back plate, OR
- **5.5.** Affix wood screws at all fixing points.
- 5.6. Place the female sections in the opposite holes, lining them up with the male thread. (Figure 7.)
- 5.7. Secure loosely by hand, then use a screwdriver to hold the female section while tightening the male section with a second screwdriver.
