FINISHES

Bankston's premium hardware is crafted from **solid forged brass**, which possesses antirust and anti-microbial properties.

Cycle-tested to 500,000 cycles* (the highest benchmark in the industry) Bankston's core range complies with industry standards for fire resistance for commercial use.

Brushed Chrome

Surface— Brushed satin texture. Durability— Suitable for most external and internal applications.

Finish Process— A nickel-plated brass product is linished before receiving an additional plating of chromium, resulting in an extremely hard-wearing and stable finish.



Polished Chrome

Surface— High shine/reflective. Durability— Suitable for most external and internal applications.

Finish Process— A nickel-plated brass product is highly polished before receiving an additional plating of chromium, resulting in an extremely hard-wearing and stable finish.



Nero

Surface— Matt. Durability— Suitable for most external and internal applications. Finish Process— Powder-coat finish.



Neutralis

Surface— Semi-gloss. Durability— Suitable for most external and internal applications. Finish Process— UV stabilised powder-coat finish.

Brushed Champagne

Surface— Brushed satin texture. Durability— Medium to high durability for most external and internal applications. Finish Process— Solid forged brass is lightly linished on a polishing wheel before a clear satin lacquer is applied to protect its surface.



Smooth Nickel

Surface– Brushed satin texture. Durability– Medium to high durability for most external and internal applications. Finish Process– Nickel-plated solid forged brass is very lightly linished prior to being plated with nickel a second time for a smooth sheen.



Bronzed Brass

Surface— Brushed satin texture. Durability— Enhancing its natural properties, it is designed to patina naturally over time, lightening in particular upon areas more frequently touched, suitable for most external and internal applications. Finish Process— This finish

is crafted by a hand-ageing process, providing a matt satin surface with tonal gradations.



Polished Brass

Surface— High shine/reflective. Durability— Suitable for most external and internal applications.

Finish Process— Raw forged brass is polished at high-speed. A clear lacquer is then applied to produce a mirror-like finish that will develop over time.

Sans-Arc Studio are an award-winning design and architecture firm renowned for creating human-oriented spaces full of wonder and excitement that sit firmly outside of the norm. In partnership with Bankston Architectural they have co-created a limited-edition collection of bold door hardware that celebrates the joy in the unexpected.

The Bankston + Sans-Arc Studio, Super Collection largely draws inspiration from the Radical Design Movement of the 1960s, a period that heralded a new way of thinking, encouraging daring explorations of shape, colour and material.

These principles have served as the foundation of the Bankston + Sans-Arc Super Collection and are reflected in each product. Playful geometric abstractions and unique forms are balanced with highly functional design, delivering a range that feels both usable, yet is highly expressive.

Super Moon

Super Moon is named after its shape; it is round – like the moon, and big, so super! Super Moon celebrates the inherent beauty and simplicity of shape, exhibiting strength and assurance with every engagement.

Futurismo

Inspired by Futurist design, the Futurismo is geometrically subversive and introduces unexpected shapes into a lever. A sphere and chamfered rod are elegantly stacked to create a unique and eye-catching piece.



Zzzigurat

The Zzzigurat draws its distinctive shape from the ancient Mesopotamian ziggurat, a stepped structure that pre-dates the pyramids of Egypt. The name also pays homage to one of the key design practices (Zzigurat) associated with the Radical Design Movement. The bold shape of the Zzzigurat makes it ideal for more playful and animated spaces.

Associati

Slightly more serious in approach, yet whimsical and imaginative. With the elements stripped back and reduced to only what is needed, the Associati is simple, minimalist-a line and a dot.

"This is not like other door hardware. These are little bits of sculpture for your doors. This collection is made of lots of different shapes. You can put them in your palazzo, pool house or pavilion. Form vs. function? We think both. Form and function. Ok?"

Geppetto

The Geppetto, named after the levers Pinocchio-like shape, is subtly linked to the Italian theme of radical design, whilst embracing a slightly absurdist design approach. Playing off contrasting geometries, the Geppetto's simple form is bold yet timeless.

Sans-Arc's Bowden Brewing Project

Within a revitalised warehouse in the inner west of Adelaide, Bowden Brewing is a microbrewery producing small batch and unique beer.

Playing off the industrial setting, the boundary wall is inspired by temporary fencing and layers of raw steel mesh and a concrete floor tie into the basebuild. These elements are balanced against warmer tones of walnut timber, beige modular tiles and textural orange upholstery that create an offbeat and slightly 70s colour palette.

Spread across two levels, the space is layered and delicately balanced between convivial and industrial, making a really big shed feel comfortable and welcoming.

Civilian's Bedford-Stuyvesant Townhouse, New York

Founded in 2018 by architects Nicko Elliott and Ksenia Kagner, Civilian is a building and interior design studio located in New York that works with cultural institutions, forward thinking companies, and creative individuals to tell their stories through design.

Civilian transformed the interiors of an 1890's townhouse, updating its historic layout for modern-day living and incorporating a playful and eclectic

mix of vintage and contemporary design. The project draws from a diverse mix of references, from the rich material palette found in Milanese homes to the bold use of colour in the work of French architect Robert Mallet-Stevens. The resulting space foregrounds Nicko and Ksenia's creative circle of artists and makers while maintaining a sense of comfort and ease that supports the daily rituals of their growing design practice and young family.

Higher Ground

A nod to the Bauhaus movement, the minimal lines of the Berlin collection balances rational detail with streamlined execution. The door lever's solid, industrial aesthetic – comprising an elongated tubular form over a robust angular return – pairs perfectly with the collection's matching privacy turns, pull handles and cupboard knobs, and can be fitted upon a round or square rose, and rectangular, oval or chamfered backplate.

Clean Lines

The clean lines of the Berlin range acknowledge the simplified forms and rationality of the Bauhaus movement of the early 20th century.

Manufactured from solid forged brass, the Berlin range features complementary door levers, privacy turns, pull handles and cupboard knobs in matching finishes.

Solid State

Behind its distinctly flat oval surface, the reverse of the Bronte door lever is gently rounded to ensure optimum comfort and a smooth grip. Stunning on a round or square rose or paired with a sleek oval or rectangular backplate, it adapts seamlessly to any space. The collection also includes privacy turns plus cupboard knobs with robust flattened circular planes.

Diamond Knurling

Stylistically similar to our Berlin door lever with its elongated tubular form surrounding an angular rod, its grip is forged with diamond knurling. Bold yet understated, it resonates with sensorial appeal whether fitted to a round or square rose or a rectangular, oval or chamfered backplate. Pull handles and cupboard knobs in assorted sizes complement the collection, whilst privacy turns also feature the distinguished diamond knurling finish.

The durability and appearance of our lacquered finishes is strictly connected with the user's care. Longevity of the lacquer is dependent on day-to-day usage and a number of environmental factors. Direct application of abrasive cleaners or chemicals containing alcohol will accelerate the breakdown of the lacquer, and should be avoided.
