Black is a common request and bronze / brown options are becoming popular for external side joinery when paired with our Weathered Brass Dark (WBD) finish on the internal handles. This ensures your external 'living finished' products remain brown rather than potentially turning Verdigris, especially an issue in highly exposed coastal areas.
