





Door preparation and latch installation (steps 1-9)

<p>Mark line on the door face approx 1000mm from the floor. Cut along --- dashed line. Fold page on door edge.</p> <p>Align CL on template with marked line on door face.</p>	<p>Find centre of door and mark ready for drilling 25mm latch hole.</p> <p>Mark hole position ready for drilling 16mm furniture hole both sides of door.</p>	<p>Drill 2mm pilot hole for the furniture both side of door.</p>	<p>① Drill 25mm latch hole to depth of 80mm, ensure hole is drilled squarely. ② Drill a 16mm furniture hole, ③ & ④ Drill 3x 10mm holes, from both sides of door to prevent splintering.</p>	<p>Insert latch into 25mm hole.</p> <p>Mark around latch face plate and chisel out recess.</p> <p>Face plate must be flush with door face.</p>
				<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Fold here on door edge</p>
<p>Insert latch with the curved side of the latch bolt facing in the direction that the door closes.</p>	<p>PRIVACY LATCH ONLY</p> <p>To reverse the privacy latch bolt handing (for doors that open outwards).</p> <p>Remove the circlip and assemble to opposite side.</p>	<p>Set circlip position on the exterior door side.</p> <p>Privacy pin on the interior door side.</p>	<p>Drill 2x 2mm pilot holes and affix screws provided.</p>	<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Fold here on door edge</p>

Passage and Privacy set installation (steps 10 - 21)

 <p>Privacy button</p>				
<p>PRIVACY SET (displayed) Parts and assembly DO NOT REMOVE SCREWS</p>	<p>Position lever assembly (side with screws) so that it operates downward to retract the latch bolt.</p>	<p>Align spindle into the square opening in latch, screws pass through screw holes.</p>	<p>Locate opposite lever (side without screws), align screw heads through large screw holes in furniture.</p>	<p>Rotate rose furniture to align screws with countersunk holes.</p>
	 <p>Removal tab</p>	 <p>Emergency access hole</p>		
<p>Lightly tighten fixing screws. Check levers are horizontal and in line with the latch. Then firmly tighten fixing screws.</p>	<p>Pass trim over lever. Push trim to secure. Position removal tab to the bottom.</p>	<p>PRIVACY SET ONLY On the exterior side of door align emergency access holes on trim and furniture.</p>	<p>PRIVACY SET ONLY Screw in the privacy button on the interior side of door through hole in trim.</p>	<p>PRIVACY SET ONLY Depressing the privacy button will lock the (exterior) outside lever.</p>
		<p>* FOR OUTWARD OPENING DOORS REFER TO STEP 7 & 8.</p>		
<p>PRIVACY SET ONLY Rotate (interior) inside lever to release privacy lock.</p>	<p>PRIVACY SET ONLY Insert and push pointed tool to gain access from the (exterior) outside when the privacy button is engaged.</p>			

Strike preparation and installation (steps 22 - 27)

		 <p>Door stop</p>		
<p>Partially close door. Mark centre of latch bolt. Mark horizontal line along the inside face of the door jamb.</p>	<p>Measure the door thickness and halve it.</p>	<p>From the door stop along the horizontal line, measure and mark a vertical line at half the door thickness.</p>	<p>At this point drill 25mm hole, 13mm deep into the door jamb.</p>	<p>Align strike plate centrally and vertically over this hole. Mark around plate. Chisel out jamb to allow strike plate to sit flush.</p>
	<p>Drill 2x 2mm pilot holes and affix screws provided.</p>
