

BACK TO BACK FIXING




Mark fixing position on door and drill holes for through bolts. Ensure adequate space is provided for clearance of knuckles on door jamb.



Screw mounting to face of door with wood screws supplied.



Attach through bolts to handle mounts. Place through door and attach mounts for other side. Tighten up mounts back to back.




Fix handle base plates over mounts and attach handle using grub screws supplied.

SINGLE HANDLE REAR FIX



Mark fixing position on door and drill holes for through bolts. Ensure adequate space is provided for clearance of knuckles on door jamb.



Screw mounting to face of door with wood screws supplied.

Fit threaded rod to handle mount and place through door. Attach decorative cap and tighten with Allen key supplied.




Fix handle base plates over mounts and attach handle using grub screws supplied.

SINGLE HANDLE FACE FIX




Mark fixing position on door. Ensure adequate space is provided for clearance of knuckles on door jamb.
